All medications are provided through the Home's Pharmacy and administered by nursing staff.

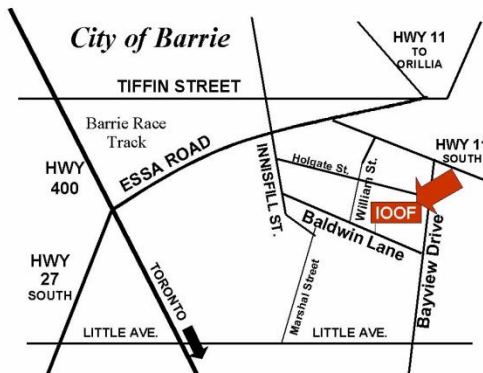
"Caring IS OUR Reason for Being"

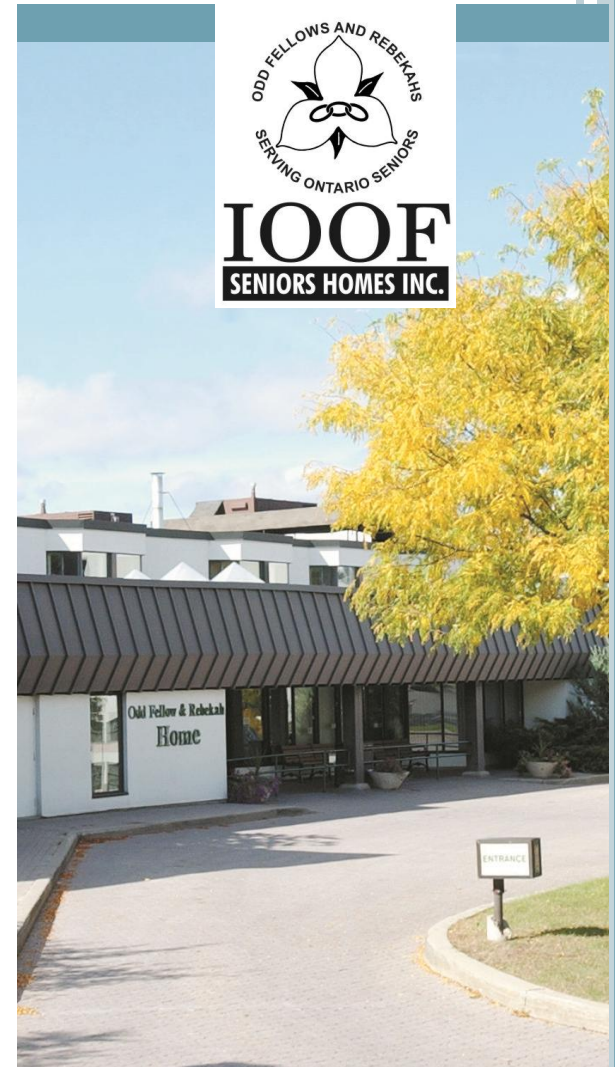

About the Program:

Convalescent Care at the IOOF Seniors Homes is a short stay program that provides rehabilitation services to those who require a period of time to convalesce as they recover from surgery or illness. The focus of the program is to ensure the individual is actively involved in regaining strength, endurance, and functioning. The goal is to support independence so the individual can return home.

How do I access the program?

Referrals are coordinated through the Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) please contact 1-888-721-2222

Convalescent Care needs will be assessed for a minimum of 7 day stay up to a maximum of 90 days per calendar year.

Is there a cost for the program:

There is no cost for the care and accommodation to participate in the program. The Program is funded through the Ministry of Health & Long Term Care.

Individual Care Plan:

Along with an interdisciplinary care team goals will be developed based on individualized needs. Each care plan will be developed with each individual in collaboration with a group of core team members including:

Services include:

- 24 hour nursing and personal care
- Rehabilitation services and treatment including TENS, Ultrasound, Hot Packs
- A well equipped Physio Gym
- Medical care provided by physician and on site nurse practitioner
- Three nutritious meals and three snacks throughout the day
- Social, recreational and spiritual programs
- Housekeeping
- Accessibility to Laundry Machines (will require laundry detergent)
- Seating and mobility assessments are available prior to discharge if required
- Access to all Resident lounges, outdoor courtyard and campus amenities.
